ARTWORK INFORMATION

- Artwork must be two-dimensional, framed or gallery wrapped, wired, and ready to be hung and no larger than 48" in height or width;
- Work previously exhibited at Sacred Heart Cultural Center is NOT allowed;
- Sacred Heart retains the right to reject work deemed inappropriate for exhibition in the Art Hall;
- Each artist is invited to submit up to two pieces of art;
- There will be a limited number of exhibiting space available:
- All work must be for sale. Artists receive 70% commission;
- Artwork to be delivered to Sacred Heart by Friday, August 20.
