

Garden Description - 2216 Cumming Road

This lovely Summerville cottage was built in 1950 by Dorothy Manise, a female golfer who was known as the “patron saint of the Women’s Titleholder Golf Tournament.” She loved the location of her home because of its proximity to the golf course of the Augusta Country Club and to her family who lived nearby on Milledge Road. The home’s current owner, Freddie Flynt, raised her family in the home and loves its serene atmosphere and convenient location to so many Augusta amenities. Ms. Flynt travels extensively and is always happy to come home to her white picket fenced garden.

The front garden gets great sunlight and is filled with blooms from early spring until late fall each year. Freddie has continued to add annuals, perennials, herbs and vegetables to her cozy front garden. Note the dirt sidewalk that runs in front of her home: unpaved sidewalks are a long-standing tradition in Summerville and her neighborhood has maintained this charming tradition that harkens back to a bygone era of genteel Southern living.
