

**The garden of Margie & Robert McElreath
2711 Hillcrest Avenue, Augusta, GA**

The front garden is a four-year-old reinterpretation of a space previously dominated by a pair of large oak trees. It is a geometric layout of evergreen elements and pathways, softened and populated with small-scale deciduous trees, flowering shrubs, and herbaceous perennials.

The back garden is a mildly stylized woodland garden. Beginning its second full year, this work-in-progress features its original oak tree as well as repurposed Indica azaleas trimmed into tree forms. Various shade-appreciating evergreens and flowering shrubs are the initial elements to create a sense of place.
