The wonderful garden on Applegate has a wide and diverse variety of plants—too many to list, in fact! Garden owner, Bonnie, has lovingly selected her favorites for guests to identify as you tour. We recommend downloading a plant identification app on your phone to identify those plants not on the following list.

1. Autumnalis, Autumn Flowering Cherry
2. Japanese Maple seedlings lining driveway and throughout
3. Native Azaleas in driveway and back yard
4. Large Agave in front, left of house
5. Vitex and Apricots in front yard
6. Liguria throughout garden
7. Hellebores throughout in pots and in garden
8. Collection of Pitcher Plants in pot garden and in bog and pond
9. *Corylopsis spicata* in old iron sugar kettle behind bamboo curtain
10. Hostas throughout in pots and garden
11. Contorted Mulberry tree
12. Ferns throughout: Tassel fern, Japanese Painted fern, Korean Rock fern and others
13. *Hydrangea Eva Holmes* (named by Ted Steven's)

Plant List for 2223 Kings Way, Augusta



<u>Plant Name</u>	<u>Description</u>
Autumn Rouge®	Encore Azalea with deep reddish-pink semi-double ruffled blooms; evergreen shrub, 4–4.5 ft tall/wide, blooms spring to fall.
Autumn Chiffon™	Encore Azalea with bicolor pale pink flowers and deeper pink patterning; compact reblooming evergreen, 2.5–3 ft.
Nikko Blue Hydrangea	Bigleaf hydrangea with large mophead blooms (blue in acidic soil, pink in alkaline); deciduous shrub, 4–6 ft tall.
Sasanqua: Mine-No-Yuki (White Doves)	Fall-blooming camellia with profuse sparkling white semi-double blooms; upright evergreen shrub, 5–8 ft.
Sasanqua: Debutante (pink)	Camellia (often listed under japonica or sasanqua) with large light pink peony-style blooms; vigorous evergreen, 8–10 ft.
Hydrangea paniculata Vanilla Strawberry™	Panicle hydrangea with large blooms changing from white to pink to strawberry red; upright deciduous shrub, 6–8 ft.
Emerald Green Arborvitae (Thuja occidentalis 'Smaragd')	Narrow pyramidal evergreen with dense bright emerald green foliage; great for screening, 10–15 ft tall.
Camellia: Shishi (pink) / Shishi Gashira	Fall/winter-blooming camellia with hot pink semi-double blooms and golden centers; compact evergreen, 4–6 ft.
Camellia: Kanjiro (red)	Sasanqua camellia with cerise/bright pink semi-double blooms and golden stamens; upright evergreen, 8–10 ft.
Camellia: Yuletide (red)	Winter-blooming camellia with bright red single blooms and yellow stamens; compact evergreen.
Camellia: Pink Snow (pink)	Sasanqua camellia with light/carnation pink shaggy semi-double blooms; robust fall bloomer, upright evergreen.
Camellia Japonica: Colonial Dame (white)	Winter/early spring bloomer with large semi-double to peony white blooms; upright evergreen shrub.
Camellia Japonica: Debutante (pink)	Large light pink peony-style blooms over a long season; vigorous evergreen, 8–10 ft.
Camellia Japonica: Professor Sargent (red)	Fully double peony-form brilliant red blooms in late winter to spring; upright evergreen, 8–10 ft.
Hydrangea Bobo	Compact dwarf panicle hydrangea with abundant upright white blooms turning pink; 2–3 ft tall.
Hydrangea paniculata Vanilla Strawberry™	(Repeated entry) Large color-changing panicle blooms (white → pink → red); 6–8 ft.
Drift Rose: Apricot, White, Coral, Red, Popcorn, Peach, Pink	Low-growing groundcover roses with continuous small blooms in various colors; disease-resistant, compact.
Knockout Rose: Red, Pink, Double Red	Tough, continuously blooming shrub roses with excellent disease resistance; 3–4 ft bushy habit.
Madison Star Jasmine	Fragrant evergreen vine with clusters of creamy white star-shaped flowers; glossy green leaves, twining habit.
Fatsia (Fatsia japonica)	Bold tropical-looking evergreen shrub with large glossy palmately lobed leaves; creamy white fall flowers, 6–16 ft.
Crimson Fire™ Loropetalum	Compact dwarf fringe flower with ruby-red to burgundy foliage and bright pink spidery blooms; 2–4 ft.

Trees: Pomegranate, Satsuma Orange, Augusta grapefruit, Lemon, Olive, Pinnate Palms, Washingtonian Palm, Oriental Magnolia, Red Maples, Japanese Maples, Crepe Myrtle, Oak, Loquat, American Elm

Shrubs: Tea Olive, Loropetalum, Boxwoods, Hydrangea (oak leaf & others), Azaleas (native & domesticated), Camilla, Podocarpus, blueberries, Angel Trumpet, Sweet Shrub, Forsythia, Clubmoss, Ligustrum, Nandina, Lantana, Cast Iron Plant, Arbor vitae, Red Bud, Juniper

Garden plants: *Herbs:* ginger, parsley, garlic chives, thyme, rosemary, oregano, French sorrel, sages, fennel, basil; *Vegetables:* tomatoes, peppers, eggplant, squash & cucumbers, birdhouse gourd, lettuce, chard, snap peas & kale

Flowers: Rudbeckia, Iris, Gladiolus, Rose Champion, Echinacea, day lilies, Easter lilies, Linden rose, Snap Dragon, rose, Pheasants Eye, Yarrow, Pansies, Coreopsis, Swamp Daisys, Peony, Crinum, Flox, Aster (native & domesticated), Red Hot Poker, Black-eyed Susan, Cleome, Zinnia, Mexican Petunia, Cannas, Amaryllis, wildflower mix
